1. Summary

1.1 The schedules attached as Appendix 1 to this report detail applications received for LAC grant funding from this meeting of the LAC.

- 1.2 Taking into account past experience, consideration of grant applications at the May cycle of LAC meetings has proved to be time consuming. - 1.3 At the last meeting of this LAC held in May 2015 an applications was continued to allow the applicants the opportunity to attend this meeting and, if required, provide additional oral information in relation to their application. Accordingly, all applicants have been invited to attend this meeting.
- 1.4 Following the last meeting of this LAC it became apparent that one application had been omitted from the agenda. The application, from Johnstone Activity Group, had been submitted to three LACs. It was continued at Renfrew and Gallowhill (request was £100); Paisley South awarded £100; and, based on membership, an award of £300 should have been requested from the Johnstone & the Villages LAC. The Director of Finance & Resources, in consultation with the Convener, agreed to a request that such an award be made and, accordingly, the LAC is now requested to homologate that decision.

2.2 That the decision taken by the Director of Finance & Resources, in consultation with the Convener, to award £300 to Johnstone Activity Group be homologated.
