### **Recording of Meeting**

Prior to the commencement of the meeting, the Chair intimated that this meeting of the Local Partnership would be recorded and that the recording would be available to watch on the Council's website.

### **Declarations of Interest**

C Williams (REEM) declared an interest in Item 2 - Applications for Local Partnership Funding in Paisley North, West and Central - 2021/22 (FR1101) - as she was a volunteer with Renfrewshire Effort to Empower Minorities (REEM) and indicated that she would remain in the meeting but not take part in discussions or voting thereon.

J Wilby (Paisley West & Central Community Council) declared an interest in Item 2 - Applications for Local Partnership Funding in Paisley North, West and Central - 2020/21 (FR1195) - as he was the Secretary of the Paisley West & Central Community Council and indicated that he would remain in the meeting but not take part in discussions or voting thereon.

### 1. Minute of Previous Meeting

There was submitted the Minute of the meeting of the Local Partnership held on 9 February 2021.

**<u>DECIDED</u>**: That the Minute be approved.

# 2. Paisley North West and Central Local Partnership Budget Monitoring Report and 20/21 Funding Application Feedback

There was submitted a report by the Chief Executive relative to funds allocated by Paisley North West and Central Local Partnership in 2020/21 which were detailed in a table within the report. The budget position at the date of this meeting, was attached as an appendix to the report.

Feedback from projects who had received funding in 20/21 was also attached with information being provided on the impact of Covid 19 had on the ability of groups to successfully deliver projects. Some groups had returned funding to the Local Partnership, as a result of restrictions in place over the period. In recognition of that situation it had been agreed that Local Partnership underspends in 2020/21 would be carried forward and added to the budget for 2021/22. For 2021/22, the normal arrangements would apply, which required all funding to be spent by the end of the financial year with no provision for carry over to the following year.

**<u>DECIDED</u>**: That the budget monitoring report and feedback from recipients of funding in 2020/21 be noted.

## 2. Applications for Local Partnership Funding in Paisley North, West & Central – 2021/22

There was submitted a report by the Chief Executive relative to applications for Local Partnership funding in Paisley North, West & Central for 2021/22.

The report intimated that applications for funding from the Local Partnership had been invited to reflect the Local Partnership's priorities of Community Empowerment, Tackling Social Isolation to Promote Health, Green Spaces and Community Safety. The available allocation for Paisley North, West and Central was £57,957 made up of £45,822 from the General Fund, £9,750 from Paisley Common Good Fund and £2,385 underspend carried forward from 2020/21. The sum of £50 per community representative required to be ringfenced for potential claims for administrative expenses, which left a balance of £57,457 for allocation.

The report advised that the Youth Challenge Fund component of Paisley North, West and Central's funding, was £21,133. This would be allocated by young people through a participatory budgeting process and would be allocated during autumn 2021.

The Chair proposed a method for considering the applications, which could be amended as appropriate, as each application was discussed. This was agreed.

Following consideration, the Local Partnership agreed that the undernoted applications be determined as follows:- (PR denotes awarded on a pro-rata basis).

### TITLE:

Paisley North West and Central Local Priorities Workshop

### 1. Summary

- 1.1 Paisley North West and Central Local Partnership has agreed a set of local priorities for the area on which it wishes to see progress made. The four priorities are: Community Empowerment; Tackling Social Isolation To Promote Health; Green Spaces; and Community Safety. These priorities are set out in Appendix 1 and include some specific points that members wanted to see progresse
- 1.2 These local priorities have been used in the first instance to guide allocation of Paisley North West and Central Local Partnership funding. However, there may be other actions that the members of the Local Partnerships and their organisations could take to progress the local priorities.
- 1.3 Taking specific points under each of the four local priorities Local Partnership members are invited to discuss in a workshop format at the meeting:

What can we do together as a Local Partnership to:

- Activate new local community groups.
- Explore sustainability of existing groups, including succession planning.
- Raise awareness of the availability and sustainability of funding opportunities for local groups.
- Connect people to each other.
- Enable people to get to Paisley town centre to access services.
- Develop and maintain high quality Green Spaces.
- Use Green Spaces to promote physical and mental health.
- Address safety and lighting to make Green Spaces accessible at night.
- Enable people to move around their area safely.
- Make activities available for young people.

1.4 Ideas generated from the discussion will be collated and used to identify possible actions, for agreement at the next Local Partnership meeting in February 2022.

## 2. Recommendation

2.1 It is recommended that members of the Local Partnership participate in the workshop session and agree to the way forward outlined at paragraph 1.4.

### Paisley North West and Central Local Partnership Priorities

### **Community Empowerment**

The Local Partnership want more people to get involved in their community. They want to activate new community groups, and explore the sustainability of the local groups that already exist. This includes succession planning for groups and exploring the availability and sustainability of funding for groups in the area.

### Tackling social isolation to promote health

The Local Partnership want to help connect people to each other and see this as key to promoting health and wellbeing in the area. They think a key barrier is people being able to physically get to Paisley town centre to access services and groups.

### Green spaces

The Local Partnership want to see the development and maintenance of high-quality green spaces in the area, and the use of these spaces to promote physical and mental health. They particularly want address safety and lighting in order to safely access these spaces at night.

## Community safety

The Local Partnership want to help people to feel safe in their community. This includes being able to move around the area safely, by tackling issues with pavements and pathways, dog fouling and litter. They also think it is important that there are activities available for young people to avoid them becoming involved in anti-social behaviour and crime.
