1. Summary

- 1.1 The schedules attached as Appendix 1 to this report detail applications received for LAC grant funding from this meeting of the LAC.
- 1.2 Taking into account past experience, consideration of grant applications at the May cycle of LAC meetings has proved to be time consuming. Members are also asked to take into consideration the total potential value of the applications as £134,204.13 which exceeds available resources.


