Local Outcome Improvement Plan

- 10 year plan
- Replaces Community Plan 2013 2023 and Single Outcome Agreement
- Renfrewshire wide, focusing on improving outcomes and reducing inequalities
- Published by 1st October 2017
- Key task of "understanding local needs" role for LACS and individual community organisations

Locality Plans

- Identifies communities where the outcomes (e.g. Life expectancy, health, unemployment, crime etc.) are significantly poorer than elsewhere in Scotland/ Renfrewshire
- Communities 10,000 30,000
- Small (but not fixed) number of Locality Plans can be geographical areas or "communities of interest"
- Focus on reducing inequalities in a specific local area by improving outcomes



What our information tells us

 Greatest inequality of outcomes in Johnstone and the Villages LAC:

Johnstone – c 5,000

And elsewhere in Renfrewshire:

Linwood – c 5,000

Paisley North – c 7,000

Paisley North West/Ferguslie – c 10,000

Gallowhill – population c 3,000

Renfrew West/North – population c 2,000

What our information tells us

- Health is a key driver of deprivation in Renfrewshire.
- More areas in Renfrewshire are health deprived than in Scotland as a whole and the difference has increased over time.
