## 1. Summary

- 1.1 A request was received from two Councilors who expressed a wish in attending a conference "Councillors' Guide to Understanding your Council's Financial Reporting Requirements".
- 1.2 The Conference took place on 24 August 2023 by way of a Webinar, and the Board is requested to homologate the actions of the Director of Finance & Resources in making the necessary arrangements for their attendance. The cost of the conference was £175 per person.
- 1.3 The conference, organised by FAN (Finance Advisory Network) workshop was designed specifically to provide local authority elected members with greater insight into the financial reporting requirements of their authority, giving them the knowledge and confidence to deliver effective engagement, scrutiny and challenge of the Statement of Accounts as part of their overall governance role.
- 1.4 The workshops also discussed the financial resilience considerations for local authorities and how the statement of accounts can assist elected members in spotting any warning signs and seeking assurance, as well as explaining the main differences between local authority accounts and the financial statements of companies.
