Attendance at Joint Board Meetings

1. Summary

- 1.1 The Joint Board's procedural standing orders state:

If the board is not satisfied about why the member has failed to attend, it will tell that member's constituent authority so that they can consider ending the appointment of that member and appointing a replacement member.
