"In line with the Community Empowerment Bill"


"Agree a local action plan to reflect the needs of local communities"

Underrepresentation of some groups

"More access and representation from voluntary organisations should be promoted and facilitated"

Lots of community representatives wanted to vote / more of a say

"LAC members have become disenchanted as they feel their input was irrelevant and that decisions had already been made"

Some felt it right and proper for elected members to make decisions due to their democratic mandate

"Only elected members should have a vote, they are the ones with the elected mandate from the community"

Meetings - What people told us

Some people welcomed the formality and the professionalism of the meeting style

Formal committee style of meetings could be offputting for new or less confident members

"its quite intimidating for wee voluntary and community groups and a bit impersonal at times"

Accessibility is important, especially making sure people can hear

Clear and plain English, less jargon and fewer lengthy officer reports

Publicity surrounding the meetings and communication of their activities could be improved

Grants - What people told us

- •LACs fund hundreds of community led groups all over Renfrewshire
- •Principles are sound, but not enough structure for an oversubscribed system
 - Process is long and sometimes difficult
 - •Many in favour of scoring applications against a set of criteria
 - Mixed views on what types of applications should be supported
 - Applications from Council services and multi-area applications should be reviewed
 - A number of community organisations have negative experiences
 - Support for more feedback, monitoring and evaluation
