



- Renfrewshire has 32 parks which provide a wide range of opportunities for leisure, sporting and cultural activities as well as contributing to the aesthetics of their neighbourhoods and communities
- Council has committed £1M (overall £2.25m) investment in Robertson Park to enhance this well used asset



- Investment announced at Council in March 2016 with an update at Council in September 2016 of Masterplan proposals (see following slide on outcome of Master Plan work)
- External tender process December 2016 into January 2017
- Procurement Sub-Committee for Civils on 15
 February and Play Areas on 15 March 2016



Master Plan

- Consultation by the Council working in partnership with the Renfrew Community Council and RDT to prepare an ambitious Master Plan which details a community vision for the park.
- Consultation events, online questionnaires and interviews with groups operating in the park.
- The Master Plan comprises ambitious proposals to replace or repair infrastructure within the park (in particular paths, & drainage), create an outdoor performance venue and introduce new play facilities.





Works included in the tenders:-

- Drainage works in various locations
- Path improvements in various locations
- Play equipment for older children to compliment the existing play facilities for younger children
- Specialist staff resource to look at future phases of works and external funding in order to deliver the Master Plan

Communications going forward

- Regular monthly communications with Ward Members, Renfrew CC, RDT, other community groups and general public
- Progress updates to Environment Policy Board

Impacts on Park Usage

- Certain areas (not full park)will be closed to the public during construction works - plan available
- Works are phased to maximise accessibility to areas within the park during the works
- Events may require to be reconfigured and/or relocated within the park
