Local Outcome Improvement Plan

- 10 year plan
- Replaces Community Plan 2013 – 2023 and Single Outcome Agreement
- Renfrewshire – wide, focusing on improving outcomes and reducing inequalities
- Published by 1st October 2017
- Key task of “understanding local needs” – role for LACS and individual community organisations



Locality Plans

- Identifies communities where the outcomes (e.g. Life expectancy, health, unemployment, crime etc.) are significantly poorer than elsewhere in Scotland/ Renfrewshire
- Communities 10,000 – 30,000
- Small (but not fixed) number of Locality Plans – can be geographical areas or “communities of interest”
- Focus on reducing inequalities in a specific local area by improving outcomes



Timetable

February/March

- Initial community conversation, followed up by social media
- Community Planning Partnership Strategic Needs Assessment

June

- Area –based community planning events

July-September

- Local Outcome Improvement Plans and Locality Plans draft


- Plans finalised and approved

Most Deprived

- 5% Most Deprived (Rank 1 to 349)
- 5-10 % Most Deprived (Rank 350 to 698)
- 10-15 % Most Deprived (Rank 699 to 1046)
- 15-20 % Most Deprived (Rank 1046 to 1395)

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What our information tells us

- **Greatest inequality of outcomes in Renfrew and Gallowhill LAC:**

Gallowhill – population c 3,000

Renfrew West/North – population c 2,000

- **And elsewhere in Renfrewshire:**

Paisley North – c 7,000

Paisley North West/Ferguslie – c 10,000

Johnstone/Linwood – c 10,000



What our information tells us

- Health is a key driver of deprivation in Renfrewshire.
- More areas in Renfrewshire are health deprived than in Scotland as a whole and the difference has increased over time.
