**Budget Monitoring Report** 

### 1. Summary

Heading:

- 1.1 Local Area Committees (LACs) provide funding through a range of grants in terms of the General Grant Scheme, Youth Challenge Scheme and, where appropriate, the Paisley or Renfrew Common Good Funds.
- 1.2 A table detailing the funds allocated during 2014/15 is attached at Appendix 1 to this report. The LAC achieved a break-even position for its grant budgets at the financial year end.
- 1.3 The Paisley South allocation for 2015/16 totals £111,670 consisting of £65,430 General Grant Fund, £15,000 Paisley Common Good Fund and £31,240 Youth Challenge Fund.
- 1.4 This LAC also received funding from the Paisley Burgh Citizens Fund. Details of the expenditure committed to date together with remaining balances are attached as Appendix 2 to this report.
