Heading: Applications For Local Area Committee Grant Funding

1. Summary

- 1.1 The schedules attached as Appendix 1 to this report detail applications received for LAC grant funding from this meeting of the LAC.
- 1.2 Taking into account past experience, consideration of grant applications at the May cycle of LAC meetings has proved to be time consuming. Members are also requested to note that the total potential value of applications totals £123,429.09 which exceeds the available resources.


