4 LOCAL PARTNERSHIP DROP-IN CONFERENCE EVENTS 2020

There was submitted a report by the Partnerships Planning and Development Manager, Chief Executive's Service, Renfrewshire Council relative to the Local Partnership drop-in events.

The report advised that a series of Local Partnership drop-in events would take place across Renfrewshire during March 2020. It was noted that the conference events would be an opportunity for Local Partnerships to engage with the wider community, voluntary sector and with local people.
