TITLE: Gleniffer Local Partnership Funding Applications

1. Summary

- 1.1 Following initial allocations of grant in June 2021, Gleniffer Local Partnership has £7,129.75 of its 2021/22 grant budget remaining and available to allocate.
- 1.2 At the meeting of the Local Partnership held on 23 November 2022, it was agreed that a local Scout group would be invited to submit an application for funding to meet additional costs of hall hire notified to the meeting. It was also agreed that groups who received funding at the meeting held in June 2021 that was less than the full amount requested would be invited to apply for any remaining funds following consideration of the Scouts' application.
- 1.3 A summary of the new application submitted by 18th Paisley & District (Coats) Scout Group in relation to additional hall hire costs, as agreed at the meeting on 23rd November 2021, is attached to this report at Appendix 1. Additional requests for funding from other organisations previously partially funded by Gleniffer Local Partnership in June 2021 is attached for consideration at Appendix 2.
- 1.4 The new application from 18th Paisley & District (Coats) Scout Group is for £2,000 and the total of additional applications from previously-funded groups is £15,906.97. This means that the total of funding requests is £17,906.97, with available funding being £7,129.75.

2. **Recommendation**

2.1 It is recommended that members of Gleniffer Local Partnership consider the applications for Local Partnership grant funding, as set out below in Appendix 1 and 2.

To assist funding the group post covid having to relocate to more expensive council run premises in the area. Rent for our activities has seen a 300% increase on monthly costs.

Pay the rental fees on council accommodation, retaining the group in the Foxbar Gleniffer area where most if not all of our members live and go to school

Existing premises were Risk Assessed and deemed not fit for our continued use. Available premises are limited in terms of space and availability.

The current secured accommodation within the Foxbar area, provides more adequate facilities for our activities and will allow the group to deliver more balanced and varied programme of activities.

The receipt of funds will allow our dwindled financial resources focussed on our general running costs rather than see the group go into financial hardship and even debt covering significantly increased rental costs.

The funds received will be ringfenced within accounts for the purpose of Premises Rent, ensuring that we retain accommodation for the group as a priority.
