Heading: Internal Audit Plan 2021/22 - Progress

1. Summary

- 1.1 In March 2021, the Audit, Risk and Scrutiny Committee approved the Internal Audit Plan for 2021/2022 as detailed at Appendix 1 of this report.
- 1.2 The plan sets out a resource requirement of 35 days, including assurance work, reviewing the adequacy and compliance with the Local Code of Corporate Governance, time for follow up of previous recommendations, ad-hoc advice and planning and reporting.
- 1.3 This report provides an update on the progress of the internal audit plan for 2021/2022.

3. Background

3.1 Fieldwork on the planned assurance engagement on budgetary control has commenced with work expected to be completed during quarter 3. The annual review of the Local Code of Corporate Governance is due to commence in quarter 4. Planning consultations for the 2022/2023 annual audit plan will also commence in quarter 4. The audit plan remains flexible and these planned dates, could change, in consultation with management.
