# 3. Background

3.1 Paisley East, Ralston, Hawkhead & Lochfield, Hunterhill and Charleston Local Partnership agreed its membership at the meeting that took place on 24 January 2019. A space on the Local Partnership for a representative of a young persons' organisation remained unfilled following this meeting and applications from people meeting these criteria were welcomed.

- 3.2 Criteria have been developed to support members to come to a decision on the appointment of community representatives. These were set out as part of the application and are as follows:
  - Size of the community the group represents.
  - Mechanisms in place to communicate with the local community.
  - Whether a group represents or support a community of interest and how connected the group is to other community groups in the area.
